

Meranti or Saligna?

Compare the natural colour, grain and character before choosing your timber.

MERANTI



Warm, rich and characterful

- Pale yellow through to deep chocolate-brown natural tones
- More pronounced, open and varied grain
- Creates a warm, classic hardwood appearance
- Oil or sealer can deepen the colour and emphasise the grain

SALIGNA



Light, clean and understated

- Paler cream-to-soft-pink natural tone
- Finer, straighter and quieter-looking grain
- Creates a lighter, more contemporary appearance
- Stain or oil can warm and enrich the colour
- Loose knots are common and may be filled with resin, which can absorb oil or stain differently from the natural timber

Meranti: warmer and richer | Saligna: lighter and more understated

IMPORTANT

Timber is a natural material. Colour, grain and tone vary from piece to piece. The final appearance also changes with the selected sealer, oil or stain. Samples are indicative only.
